

REPORT SVDP SACRED HEART CONFERENCE

3 quarters report October 2020 through June 2021

The Saint Vincent de Paul (SVDP) Sacred Heart conference of Prescott would like to thank the church and all the parishioners for their support and kindness during the year 2021.

The donations from the church and parishioners provided shelter, purchased food, medical, dental, prescription, transportation (gas, vehicle repairs) utilities (gas, water, electricity, propane), clothing, Household items dishes, pot, pans, furniture and a visit with Santa.

Thanks to your donations we served 7,014 people with \$91,873.00 in goods and services.

Number of services 3,978 (1325 food boxes, 64 travel aid, 1666 spiritual aid/ sacraments, 923 misc.)

Volunteer donated hours 13,437

Miles driven to provide the services 21,965 at volunteer's expense

I think it's important to note that 99 percent of monies donation are for the clients.

The SVDP Thrift Store provided a donation value of \$148,946 serving 2,552 people with client aid. The donations included clothing, furniture, small appliances, dishes, and cooking utensils, etc.
