The goal of this Small Group Edge Night is for the youth to be led to a deeper desire for conversion through the repentance of sin and a turning toward Jesus Christ.

The goal of this Edge Night is to help the youth understand the Church’s teaching on same sex attraction.

The goal of this Edge Night is to help middle school youth understand they are not alone when they experience stress and overwhelming feelings, to equip them with tools to find help if they need it, and remind them of Jesus’ presence

May 2nd - “Birthday Bash: An Edge Social Night”

The middle school youth will grow in community and have an opportunity to get to know one another better by celebrating their birthdays.

May 9th - “Protecting Life: An Edge Issue Night on Abortion”

The goal of this Edge Night is to explain how both faith and reason demand that we protect unborn babies and help mothers who are considering abortion, leading the youth to feel empowered to help those who are affected by abortion.

May 16th - “Treasured: Girl Night/Dude Night”

Youth will be split by gender this night. The goal of this Edge Night is to challenge the middle school girls to look beyond the world’s perception of beauty and seek to see themselves the way God sees them.

The goal of this Edge Night is to also teach the middle school boys about being men of God. They will learn that Christ is the perfect example of what means to live the Catholic faith as a man, as well as the importance of brotherhood.
