On October 10, 2021, Pope Francis opened the Synod on Journeying Together as a Church requesting the participation of the worldwide Church. Bishop Olmsted officially opened the Synod for the Diocese of Phoenix on October 17, 2021, instructing each Parish within the Diocese to conduct consultations to reflect, share and respond to the questions of the Synod.

Sacred Heart Parish has begun the process of forming small groups to create our Parish Story based on the sharing of our faith journeys. The common thread of these individual stories will be based on the following:
