Volunteer Opportunities

Client Server: Work directly with our clients in our office or during a home visit to determine how we can help and serve them

Pantry Worker: Prepares food boxes, distributes food to clients and accepts food donations

Computer Worker: Enters data

Receptionist: Greets our clients, answers the phone, makes appointments, and files paperwork

Thrift Store Volunteer: Serves as cashier, merchandiser, driver and warehouse worker

Volunteers work flexible hours based on their availability on a week-to-week basis. **The commitment is just a couple of hours a week**. There is no long-term commitment.
