## **CALLING ALL YAVAPAI DENTISTS**

### **WHO**

- The Yavapai County Conferences of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul are establishing a community dental clinic for the under-served dental patients in our area.
- Our goal is to gather a pool of at least twelve dentists to volunteer up to four Friday mornings over the course of a calendar year.

### **WHAT**

- *The SVdP District 10 Community pilot Dental Clinic* will be an extension of the Phoenix SVdP Clinic and will provide routine dental care such as cleaning, fillings, extractions, dentures and denture repair.
- As a dentist, you will incur no expenses. All supplies and equipment will be provided for you. We only ask that you donate your time and expertise.
- All funding for the community clinic will come from donations and grants. There will be no government funding.
- All patients will be pre-screened and registered by our area SVdP Conferences. No services provided to walk-in patients.

### **WHEN**

- Our target goal for opening the community clinic is for the Fall of 2023 and operating hours will be every Friday from 8:00 AM until 12:00 noon.

### **WHERE**

- The site of the proposed community clinic is a spacious 1800-square-foot building formerly occupied by a local dentist and is located at 1000 Willow Creek Road.
